

Camp Rules

SurviveAlive Summer Camp wants every camper to have a great time, experience new activities and challenges, keep safe, eat well and make new friends.

This is how we intend to achieve this:

- Every camper has the right to privacy and personal space, and we take this seriously. The girls' tent area will be out of bounds for the boys, and the boys' tent area will be out of bounds for the girls. Any camper who is found out of bounds on more than one occasion will be sent home. If parents/carers are unavailable to collect a camper, we will contact the next of kin/emergency contact. Of course, we hope all campers will stay for the duration of our camp.
- 2. For health and safety reasons, we cannot allow any form of naked flame on our site. Therefore there is no smoking onsite. Use this as an excellent opportunity to quit!
- 3. We expect campers to demonstrate a healthy respect for each other, the leaders and all property.
- 4. While on camp we ask that you refrain from using bad language.
- 5. Alcohol and its consumption will not be tolerated.
- 6. If a camper places their own or another's life at risk then they will be returned home.
- 7. Valuables should be kept in the safety deposit box provided. Any property that is lost or stolen remains the responsibility of the owner.
- 8. Please store your mobile phone in the safety deposit box, or preferably leave it at home. Mobile phones will be confiscated for the duration of the camp if they are used disruptively.

By attending the camp you are agreeing to abide by the aforementioned rules and all the instructions from the leaders.

We hope you can understand that these measures help us to improve the camp for everyone involved.
